		the next month as part of the chancellor's Autumn Statement.

The proposed main changes that have come from the work carries out are:</li> <li>the housing allocation for South Cambridgeshire in the Plan period to be increased from 19,000 to 19,500;</li> <li>a proposed new housing allocation site in South Cambridgeshire to the north of Cherry Hinton;</li> <li>an extension of land for employment in the Addenbrookes area;</li> <li>a reduction in land for employment use in Fulbourn Road (just in South Cambridgeshire and outside the City boundary)</li> </ul> The councils will be asked to agree a public consultation (running from 2 December 2015 to 25 January 2016) on these changes.
