(TEMPORARY 40MPH AND 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)

ORDER 2020/345A

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to impose a 40mph and 30mph speed restriction along Sawston Road, Babraham and Babraham Road, Sawston as lies between Ashwell Point and Sutton House.

The Order will be effective, for safety purposes, when signs are in place indicating the speed restriction along the whole or any part of the above mentioned length of road whilst works are in progress or temporarily suspended.

The Order is made to facilitate development works and will come into operation on 4 May 2020 and will continue until these works have finished or on 3 November 2022 which ever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 4 November 2021 and 3 November 2022.

The Order shall not apply to any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service or a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer.
